

Cuyahoga Community College Foundation Lorain County Scholarship

- For the 2025-2026 academic year, scholarships will be awarded to one student from each of the following high schools:
 - Avon High School
 - Avon Lake High School
 - o North Ridgeville High School
 - Brookside High School (Sheffield)
- Students are eligible for up to \$2,000 for the 2025-2026 academic year for tuition, fees, and books.
- Students are recommended by their High School Guidance Counselor.
- To receive the scholarship, students must enroll in Tri-C no later than <u>August 15, 2025</u>.
- Scholarship is awarded for one academic year (up to \$1,000 each semester)

Criteria for the recommended students:

- 1. High School senior graduating in 2025.
- 2. Recommended by High School guidance counselor as part of scholarship application.
- 3. Students must submit application to enroll in Tri-C.
- 4. Enroll full-time at Tri-C (minimum 12 credit hours each semester).
- 5. Complete the FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov) and use the federal student aid code for Tri-C (003040).
- Complete the online Tri-C scholarship application (https://tri-c.academicworks.com/users/sign_in)
- 7. The Office of Financial Aid will confirm that students meet the academic requirements.
